

## EXAM RESULTS 2019/20

### Summary

Exams and assessments were cancelled this year due to coronavirus (COVID-19).

Where sufficient evidence was available, results were issued on the basis of “Centre Assessed Grades”. This process was also applicable to general and vocational qualifications, such as BTECs. BSL exams are usually held on demand throughout the year. No exams could be held after the lockdown in March.

During this year, 25 students took qualifications – 18 College students and 7 School Students

This year, four of the six students in Year 11 achieved a range of subjects including: GCSEs in Maths, Art and Food Preparation; EL qualifications in Maths and BTECs in Vocational Studies.

The overall pass rates for BSL were higher or considerably higher than the National Pass Rate in all units, except 202 which was much lower but based on a very small number of students.

As the number of students who took some subjects is small, to avoid identifying individual students’ specific Teacher Assessed GCSE grades, they will be shown as either “4 or above” or “3 or below”.

### School

Two students passed all the components of Entry Level English they took.

In Maths, two students passed GCSE Maths, both achieving grades of 4 or above. One student achieved Entry Level 2.

In BSL, five students passed all the components they took in Levels 1 – 3 and one student failed one of the Level 2 components.

Two students passed GCSE Art & Design (Fine Art), one with a grade of 4 or above and one with a grade of 3 or below.

One student achieved a GCSE in Food Preparation & Nutrition, with a grade of 4 or above.

Two students achieved BTEC in Vocational Studies and two students achieved BTEC in Home Cooking.

## College

Eight students passed all the components of Entry Level English they took, with five achieving the full Entry Level 3 Award.

In Maths, one student passed GCSE Maths, achieving a grade of 4 or higher. One student passed Functional Skills Maths Level 1. Nine students passed and one failed Level 1 Award in Number & Measure. One student failed Level 2 Award in Number & Measure. Six students achieved Entry Level Maths, with five at Entry Level 3 and one at Entry Level 1.

In BSL, five students passed all the components they took in Levels 1 - 3, with one student achieving the full Level 1 award.

One student passed GCSE Art & Design (Fine Art), with a grade of 3 and below.

One student achieved BTEC in Vocational Studies and one student achieved BTEC in Home Cooking.

Nine students all passed their courses at Exeter College, with two achieving distinctions.
